Why PADI Semi closed Rebreather - Drager Ray?

If stealth diving appeals to you then the PADI Semi closed Rebreather Diver - Drager Ray Specialty course will interest you. You can dive nearly bubble free after you learn to use your semi closed Rebreather - good for photography or just seeing aquatic life up close and personal.

What do I need to start?

- **PADI Advanced Open Water Diver** or **PADI Open Water Diver** certification with proof of at least 10 logged dives beyond initial training (or qualifying certification from another organization)
- PADI Enriched Air Diver certification (or qualifying certification from another organization)
- Minimum age: 15 years old



What will I do?

The course introduces semi closed rebreather dive planning, organization, procedures and potential hazards, specifically focusing on the Drager Ray semi closed rebreather.

How long will it take?

- Recommended Course Hours: 24
- Minimum Open Water Training: three dives over a recommended two days
